CMMI is a maturity model guiding improvements for software and system intensive companies. CMMI helps organizations to develop and maintain quality products and services. CMMI models are an integration of best practices from extensive experiences of many involved organizations.

With the increasing complexity of business models in product development, including off-shoring and near-shoring, as well as distributed development teams, CMMI models have proven effective to address the challenges and guide improvement work to establish an effective and efficient development organization.

This training is an unique opportunity to attend the official SEI introduction to CMMI for Development (DEV). The official training will, apart from introducing the CMMI model, give you the first step of the formal training needed to participate in a SCAMPI A team.

- understand the different process areas included in the CMMI, as well as the concept of maturity levels
